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### You can have the assessment with your doctor or one of these health care providers

You can schedule an assessment with your doctor. Or you can have one performed by one of the health assessment providers we work with. One of these companies — either MedXM® or Your Home Advantage (YHA) — may call you to make an appointment. MedXM or YHA conducts the assessment either in the comfort of your home or at a local retail clinic, where available. Their assessment:

- Is performed by a licensed/credentialed health care provider
- Includes a review of past and current health conditions, a physical exam and a review of your prescription drugs
- Takes about 30 to 45 minutes

MedXM and YHA screen for potential health conditions and send the results of the assessment to your doctor. This can make your next doctor visit more productive.
